IMPORTANT UPDATE | DEADLINE TO REQUEST A CHANGE IN FREQUENCY MODE

Dear parents and guardians,

As you know, it is possible to request a change in the mode of school attendance for your child. We would like to inform you that the parents of students in grades 9 to 12 who attend the Virtual School Learning Program (PAVÉ) or school in person have until December 11, 2020 to request a change for the 3rd and 4th quadrimesters.

To request a change of attendance mode, please go to the [CEPEO Parents Portal](#) before December 11, 2020.

If your child is currently attending PAVÉ and you want them to continue learning at PAVÉ until the end of the year, you do not need to take any action.

If your child is currently attending their school in person and you want them to continue their learning there until the end of the year, you do not have to take any action.

This communication is only intended for parents who wish to request a change to the current attendance mode.

We remind you that the quadrimesters are divided according to the following schedule:

- Term 1 from August 31, 2020 to November 6, 2020
- Term 2 from November 9, 2020 to January 29, 2021
- Term 3 from February 1, 2021 to April 16, 2021
- Term 4 from April 19, 2021 to June 25, 2021

After December 11, **changes to the method of attendance will no longer be possible for the remainder of the school year**. This will ensure that all students can take the courses required to obtain their Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD). A subsequent change request (at the end of quadrimester 3) would not allow us to ensure the continuity of education necessary to meet the requirements of the OSSD and / or a particular post-secondary program. In addition, please note that **registration for a *Consortium d'apprentissage virtuel de langue française de l'Ontario* (CAVLFO) course will not be possible after this date** for the current school year.

This decision is necessary in order to allow optimal planning of schedules and to ensure that cohorts of students are respected.
