➤ <b>BACK-TO-SCHOOL GUIDE</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Review the following steps with your child, all of which are available in the <a href="#">Back to School Guide</a>:<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ wearing a mask</li><li>○ respiratory etiquette</li><li>○ hygiene measures</li><li>○ respect for physical distancing at school</li><li>○ health and safety measures on board the school bus</li></ul></li></ul>
➤ <b>SELF-ASSESSMENT</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Screen your child EVERY DAY before arriving at school by completing the self-assessment available on the <a href="#">CEPEO website</a></li></ul>
➤ <b>ISOLATION</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Keep your child home if they are showing symptoms of COVID-19.</li></ul>
➤ <b>MASKS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>NEW</b> - Wearing a mask is mandatory for all students in <b>Grades 1 to 12</b>, while it is strongly encouraged for students in junior and senior Kindergarten.</li><li>• <b>NEW</b> - Please provide 3 spare masks for your child.</li><li>• <b>NEW</b> - Wearing a mask outdoors is mandatory when social distancing cannot be maintained.</li><li>• Scarves and neck warmers are not considered masks.</li><li>• Kindergarten to Grade 12 students must wear a mask at all times on school buses and public transit.</li></ul>
➤ <b>HAND WASHING</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Wash your hands often or use hand sanitizer, especially before touching your face, and make sure your child does the same.</li></ul>
➤ <b>PHYSICAL DISTANCING</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Respect and ensure that your child respects the physical distance of two meters or more from people who are not part of your household.</li></ul>
➤ <b>WELL-BEING AND MENTAL HEALTH</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The CEPEO is committed to creating a school environment that promotes mental health and well-being. Mental health support services will continue to be available to students in need, regardless of the delivery model or school attendance identified ( face-to-face or virtual).</li><li>• We invite you to consult the <a href="#">Well-being and Mental Health section</a> on the CEPEO website for more details.</li></ul>
