IMPORTANT UPDATE | Schools to remain open, Tuesday April 6th 2021

Dear Parents and Guardians,

The Government of Ontario has announced a province-wide lockdown effective Saturday, April 3, 2021 at 12:01 a.m. You can read the official announcement <u>here</u>.

At this time, all CEPEO schools will remain open on Tuesday, April 6. Staff will be on hand to welcome your children and ensure their well-being and education.

We will continue to monitor the situation closely and will keep you informed should schools close and a return to distance education be necessary.
