Graduation ceremonies

• For elementary schools

The celebrations marking the end of elementary school will be entirely virtual. Schools will communicate details for these celebrations to the concerned parents.

• For secondary schools

Schools will organize graduation ceremonies for graduates with a virtual and in-person component. In person, students and their families will be able to come to school one family at a time, respecting all health and safety instructions. The schools will provide parents and students with all the details relating to the organization of graduation ceremonies.

Personal Effects and Chromebook Returns

Details regarding the collection of personal effects and the return of Chromebooks will be communicated to you shortly by your child's school.

Report cards

Your child's school will inform you shortly of the details for the delivery of report cards.

Catch-up day on June 24 for students in grades 7 to 12



Childcare services

UPDATE - Government COVID-19 Screening Tool

The government's COVID-10 Screening Tool has been updated to reflect public health guidelines for people with symptoms after COVID-19 immunization.

REMINDER - Vaccination for 12 to 17 year olds

Students aged 12 to 17 can make an appointment to receive the COVID-19 vaccine online through the <u>provincial appointment scheduling system</u> or by calling the call center. They can also come to any of the <u>participating pharmacies</u> that administer the Pfizer vaccine.

Wellness and mental health resources during the summer

If your child needs the services of a mental health professional, CEPEO social workers will be available to support them from June 28 to August 27, 2021.

You can request a service by completing the <u>SUMMER 2021 - Self-referral in social work form</u>. It will be sent to one of the social workers who will contact you as soon as possible in order to follow up and direct you to the appropriate resources. Our response times will be 24 to 72 hours from Monday to Friday.

If your child is at immediate risk, please contact 911 or a crisis line such as the Youth Services Office at 613-260-2360.
