## **COVID-19 Symptoms Assessment Tool:**

- **NEW - Junior kindergarten-Grade 8 students**

Parents will be required to complete the daily self-assessment every morning for their child before they arrive at school. The updated student self-assessment tool is available on the [CEPEO website](#) and your child's school website. Verbal confirmation that students have completed their daily COVID-19 symptom self-assessment will be requested by classroom teachers each morning.

- **Reminder - Grades 9-12-adults**

Students in grades 9 to 12 will be required to complete the daily self-assessment every morning before they arrive at school. The updated self-assessment tools for students and the one for adult learners are available on the [Council's website](#) and the school's website. Verbal confirmation that students have completed their daily COVID-19 symptoms self-assessment will be requested by classroom teachers each morning.

## **REMINDER - Masks**

Wearing a mask is mandatory for all junior kindergarten to grade 12 students in all CEPEO schools. Wearing a mask is required outdoors for all students if physical distancing is not maintained between cohorts.

In closing, I want to assure you that all CEPEO staff will be present to accompany and reassure your child. We are committed to supporting our students throughout the year so that they can benefit from all the support necessary for their well-being.
