COVID-19 vaccination directive

The health and safety of our students and staff remains our priority. With this in mind, the Council of Public Schools of Eastern Ontario (CEPEO) adopted, on September 28th, a resolution on the implementation of an administrative directive on COVID-19 vaccination. This administrative policy is addressed to the following people:

- CEPEO employees;
- the drivers responsible for transporting the students;
- trainees, especially those providing professional services or following work-integrated learning (eg, future teachers);
- volunteers;
- people who provide professional services to students;
- visitors, parents or guardians, trustees and service providers who enter CEPEO premises.

The administrative directive is available on the <u>CEPEO website</u>. You will find all the modalities and important dates related to its implementation. The terms of the directive are subject to change; if so, you will be promptly informed.



Exam periods for secondary school students

Due to the current situation, the Ministry of Education has asked School Boards to position themselves regarding the holding of exam periods planned for students in grades 9 to 12 for the 2021-2022 school year in all of their schools.



In order to show goodwill towards the students and to make a decision that takes into account the reality of the schools, the pedagogical service consulted the principals of our secondary schools. It was decided to remove the exam periods from the academic calendar. Students will still have summative assessment tasks to complete but those will not be completed as part of an exam period. Systemic calendars will be updated shortly.
