Shared Materials

The use of common materials (e.g. toys, craft materials, etc.) is permitted, but we recommend that toys that can be easily disinfected be favored and that cloth / plush toys that are difficult to clean be avoided whenever possible.

Drinking Water Fountains

The use of drinking water fountains is again permitted, but the use of reusable water bottles is strongly encouraged.
