OFFICIAL COMMUNICATION

Dear Parents and Guardians,

We hope you and your loved ones are doing well. We were hopeful that the current situation would be fully restored so that our schools could be fully and quickly reopened. However, some schools still do not have electricity and will have to remain closed Wednesday, May 25. Some schools that do have electricity will also have to remain closed due to the lack of staff, some of whom still do not have electricity or water.

Teaching

Closed schools will not offer virtual or asynchronous learning. Open schools will operate as usual.
