- Understand the school's communication tools such as the newsletter, agenda, letters, forms, and school and events calendars.
- Understand the components of the report card.
- Prepare for parent-teacher meetings.
- Support your child in his or her homework.
- Take an active part in school life (educational outings, volunteering at the school, school council, etc.)
- Discover the French resources available in your community.
